## NAPOLEONICA.LA REVUE, Academic e-review on the history of the two Empires, Now accessible on CAIRN

The Fondation Napoléon and CAIRN Info have signed an agreement in view of the publication of the Fondation Napoléon's e-review, *Napoleonica.La Revue*, on CAIRN.

*Napoleonica. La Revue*, the e-journal dedicated entirely to the history of Napoleonic periods (First and Second Empires), was launched in May 2008. It publishes research articles by both established and younger historians.

After two encouraging first years and more than 1,000 pages published, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Fondation Napoléon have decided that given the excellence of the papers published in the review it should be accessible free of charge (whereas previously it had been pay-per-view).

CAIRN Info, a portal hosting more than 240 social science periodicals, has accepted the hosting of the review.

*Napoleonica. La Revue* will now benefit from many new features, notably: update alerts, reading history, bibliographical automation, author-specific update tool, etc. The site design too is elegant, rendering the articles easy to read or download in different formats (html/pdf).

Issue 7 of *Napoleonica.La Revue*, devoted entirely to music during the First Empire period, opens this partnership with Cairn.info – naturally the preceding six issues are also available via the same site.

This adoption of a major change in publishing format corresponds entirely to one of the Fondation Napoléon's core aims: to develop Napoleonic history in all its forms.
